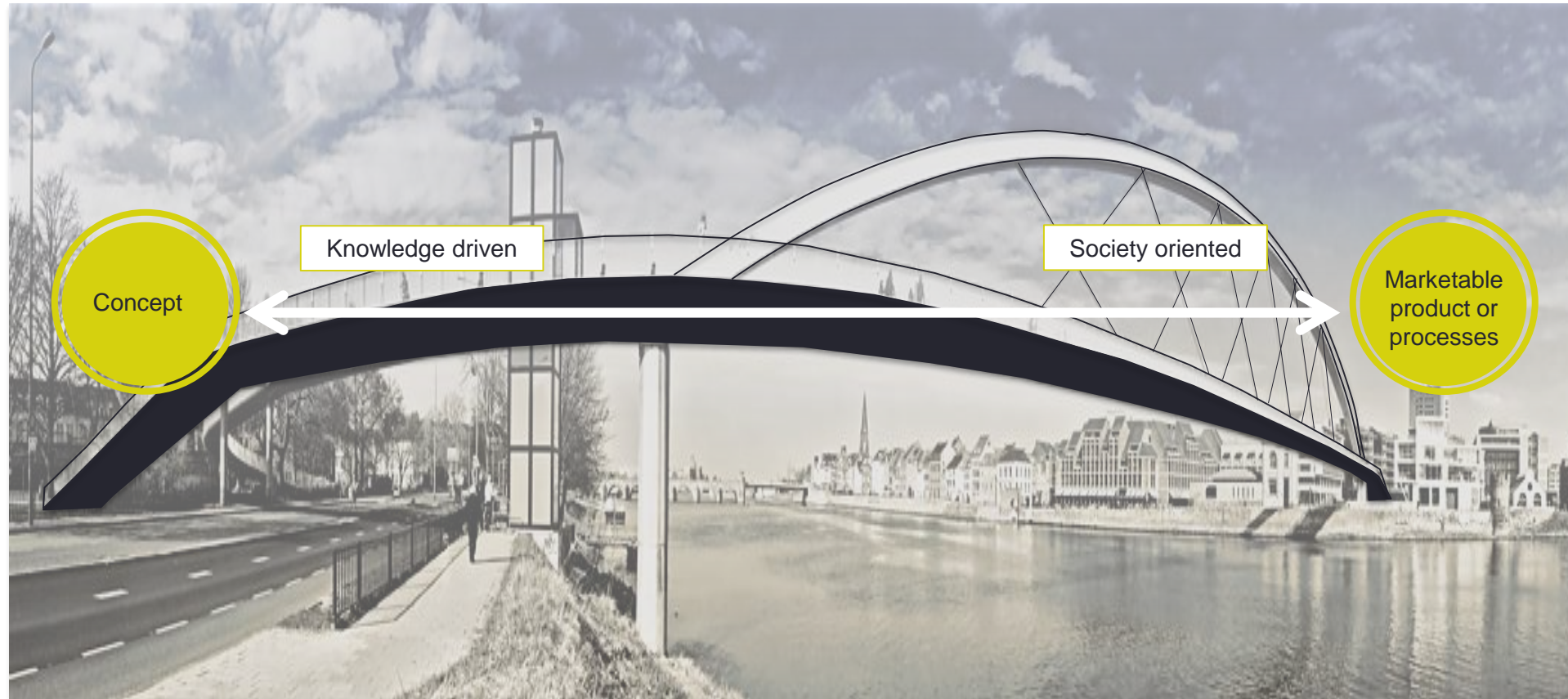

- ◆ 2 New biomedical and 2 new biobased projects were approved in the recent 3rd call, now we have 9 biomedical and 7 biobased projects
 - ~100 InSciTe researchers in these projects
- ◆ Our Lab and scale up facilities
 - Investment in two new skids for the BB facilities
 - New BM facilities, developed by Medace, ready by end of this year
- ◆ Preparing for the future of InSciTe
 - Feasibility study (by Roland Berger) was concluded
 - Now focus on a limited number of options
 - For biobased the future scope will continue to be on a more sustainable chemical industry and scale-up, including topics on recycling and other renewable feedstock
 - For biomedical, continue to build on our “Accelerator Matrix” concept
 - In general, stronger focus on the valorization and commercialization

- ◆ InSciTe now rents its facilities in Geleen from Campus
 - Rental contract ends 31/12/2019
- ◆ Medace invested in a new biomedical facility at MHC
 - InSciTe will rent from Medace as from 1/1/2020
 - InSciTe staff in our current facility will transfer to Medace
 - Medace will provide the InSciTe projects with exactly the same service and support as InSciTe would
- ◆ Danielle Curfs, Leah Evers, Jessica Gerards, Céléste Tillemans, Chris Duxbury, Rowena Simons and Youri van de Beek will leave InSciTe.
- ◆ Kurt Gielen from Brightlands Campus will join Medace
